Recipe of the Month

Beef Steak with Brown Rice & Vegetables

Ingredients:

- 1 boneless beef top sirloin steak, cut ¾ in. thick (about 1 pound)
- 1/3 cup prepared non-creamy Caesar dressing
- 2 teaspoons lemon pepper
- 1 cup uncooked instant brown rice
- 2 cups frozen vegetable mixture, such as baby green and yellow beans and carrots
- 2 tablespoons prepared non-creamy Caesar dressing
- 2 tablespoons shredded Parmesan cheese (optional)

Instructions:

- 1 Cut beef steak crosswise into four equal pieces. Place steaks and ½ cup dressing in food-safe plastic bag; turn steaks to coat. Close bag securely and marinate in refrigerator 15 minutes. Remove steaks from marinade; discard marinade. Season steaks with lemon pepper.
- 2 Heat large nonstick skillet over medium heat until hot. Place steaks in skillet; cook about 8 to 10 minutes for medium rare to medium doneness, turning once.
- 3 Meanwhile cook rice according to package directions, including salt but omitting butter. When adding rice to saucepan, stir in vegetables. When rice is done, stir in 2 tablespoons dressing. Serve with steaks. Sprinkle with cheese, if desired.

Makes 4 servings.
